

To increase effectiveness of all of the listed sprays, apply with **Turbo Spreader Sticker** at the rate of 1 Tablespoon per gallon of spray.

When	Spray	Reason
Fall (as soon as all of the leaves fall off)	Copper Fungicide followed by Horticultural Oil	Copper Fungicide helps control bacterial blights, leaf curl, and other fungal diseases. Horticultural Oil smothers insects and their eggs.
Winter 1 (when trees are dormant)	Copper Fungicide followed by Horticultural Oil	Copper Fungicide helps control bacterial blights, leaf curl, and other fungal diseases. Horticultural Oil smothers insects and their eggs.
Winter 2 (February - around Super Bowl Sunday)	Copper Fungicide followed by Horticultural Oil	Kills overwintering insects and certain disease spores on dormant trees.
Spring 1 (when buds start to swell)	Copper Fungicide	Helps control bacterial blights, leaf curls, and other fungal diseases.
Spring 2 (7 days after Spring 1 application)	Copper Fungicide	Helps control bacterial blights, leaf curls, and other fungal diseases.
Spring 3 (after 2/3 of the flower petals have fallen)	Fruit Tree Spray, Eight (Permethrin), Orchard Spray or Capt. Jack's	This application of an insecticide helps prevent insects from attacking the fruit and trees.

Remember:

- Spray the tree and ground thoroughly
- Spray fungicide and oil separately; **DO NOT MIX**
- Apply when temperature is above 40° F.

The above basic applications should control the most common diseases and insects affecting fruits. If other problems should occur, here are some suggestions of sprays to use:

Bonide or Monterey Fruit Tree Spray (Captan, Malathion and Carbaryl) - Controls both insects and diseases.

Bonide Eight (Permethrin) - Controls insects.

Bonide Fung-onil (Chlorothalonil) - Controls diseases. Can be used as a dormant spray on peaches for leaf curl.

Bonide Citrus, Fruit & Nut Orchard Spray (Sulfur and Pyrethrins) - Controls insects naturally - great for organic gardening.

Bonide All Seasons Spray Oil or Monterey Horticultural Oil - Controls insects.

Captain Jack's Dead Bug Brew (Spinosad) - Controls worms, caterpillars and borers naturally - great for organic gardening.

Monterey or Springstar Traps - Controls apple maggot and codling moth.

Copper Fungicide, Monterey Horticultural Spray, Orchard Spray and Captain Jack's Dead Bug Brew are all natural sprays and can be used in organic gardening.
